REVIEW OF ALERT LEVEL TWO PROCEDURES

On Monday 25th May, Cabinet made the decision to move raise the maximum social gathering limit of Alert Level Two from 10 to 100. This is effective from NOON 29th May. Below are the current details of Our Lady of the Valleys Parish Alert Level Two Action Plan.

Under this level of social gathering the **Bishop has removed the suspension** of **Public Masses**.

Main Points of Operating at Alert Level 2 -100 maximum social gathering

- Partial re-opening of our churches
- 4 Sunday Masses (to be trailed for a month to see if required)
- Masses will be restricted to 100 and booking in at Sunday Masses is essential to limit numbers and provide contact tracing.
- Public Masses will begin with Saturday evening Mass at 5:30 pm at Stokes Valley
- There is restrictions for Holy Communion and Sign of Peace
- Contact tracing is essential in Alert Level Two
- Social distancing (2 metres for those you don't know and 1 metre for those you do) is to be observed
- Hygiene practices are to be observed
- Access is still available, for those who choose to, to participate via on-line Masses streamed. Refer to Archdiocesan website www.wn.catholic.org.nz for details
- Weekday Mass will be available as per the scheduled listed and during LEVEL 2 parishioners may avail themselves of these services instead of attending on Sunday.
- ➤ The Plan is an evolving document and will be updated as Government and Bishops announcements allow and their practical implementation in the Parish is assessed.
- Your understanding and patience at LEVEL 2 is appreciated

PUBLIC MASSES TO RESUME FROM SATURDAY 30th MAY 5:30pm BY WHICH TIME SOCIAL GATHERING LIMIT WILL BE 100

SIGNIFICANT CHANGES TO NOTE

- An additional Mass will be offered at 5:00pm Sunday night to provide enough space at a Mass for the average Mass count as at Nov 2019.
- ➢ If you feel unsafe in large public gatherings because of the effects of COVID-19, you can attend a weekday Mass or chose to keep the day holy in other ways. As over the past weeks online services will continue to be available, or you could pray in your own homes.
- 1 metre physical spacing between bubbles is required in the Church.
- A BOOKING IN system has been created to managed the restricted numbers allowed at Masses and provide contact tracing. All INDIVIDUALS need to be recorded to accurately manage the 100 limit. The Booking system is internet based at https://www.picktime.com/OLOVMassAvailability.
- If parishioners are NOT on the internet please contact the Presbytery and the staff will book you in.
- Parishioners are URGED to come to the church early to give time to be checked into the building and to use hand sanitiser before entering the building. Please avoid a bottle-neck of arrivals in the last five minutes.
- Once the 100 limit is reached / or Mass begins the doors will be closed.
- If parishioners are NOT on the internet please contact the Presbytery and the staff will book you in.
- Contact tracing details will be recorded for all attendees.
- A COVID-19 WARDEN (with assistance) will be appointed for each Sunday Mass to monitor the implementation of the Plan.
- Between each Mass the building will need to be sanitised. Volunteers will be required to assist with this
- To reduce the amount of sanitising during the week ALL weekday Masses will be held at the Pettit Centre in Heretaunga at their regular times.

For our Plan to work – we need your COOPERATION

For Sunday Masses:

- If you are sick STAY AT HOME
- PLAN which Mass you will attend
- BOOK IN (each Mass is limited to 100 people)
- ➤ ARRIVE EARLY: the church will open 30 minutes before the start of Mass & the doors will be shut 5 minutes before the start of Mass.
- OBSERVE THE 2M/1M DISTANCING when checking in for Mass
- BE PATIENT & COURTEOUS

We need volunteers after each Mass

➤ to sanitise the church – all hard and soft surfaces to be sprayed with disinfectant and wiped down.

If anyone who has attended Mass is tested positive for COVID-19

THE CHURCH WILL SHUT FOR A FURTHER 14 DAYS
