

PETTIT CENTRE UPDATE

In December 2019 during a severe weather event the internal gutter in the roof of the Pettit Centre kitchen overflowed and water damaged the ceiling and flooded the kitchen floor for the third time in as many years

that this had happened. The Finance Committee resolved that rather than merely fixing the damaged internal ceiling a more permanent solution would be investigated to resolve the cause of the leak.

Discussions were progressed through 2020 slowed by COIVD gathering restrictions and reduced parishioner funding via weekly collections). In the second half of 2021, things started to get back to a new normal work and progress on n the project and costings etc were looked into. The work involves removal of the existing roofline over the kitchen and re-aligning it to slope all the way to the outside wall on the north side of the kitchen. The expected cost of the work was estimated at \$20,000. Other work to upgrade the kitchen and meeting space was also discussed if funds and time allow.

The work was supposed to begin in late March 2022. We were advised by the construction company that their workforce was self-isolating due to a positive COVID test. They have now advised that the work is expected to begin on Tuesday 26th April and take about 1 week.

The Parish has gained funding of \$15,000 (\$10,000 sourced from a grant from the Catholic Foundation and \$16,000 from special gifts from parishioners). If any parishioner would like to assist with a specific donation towards the shortfall of at least \$4,000 or towards the other renovations would be greatly appreciative.


