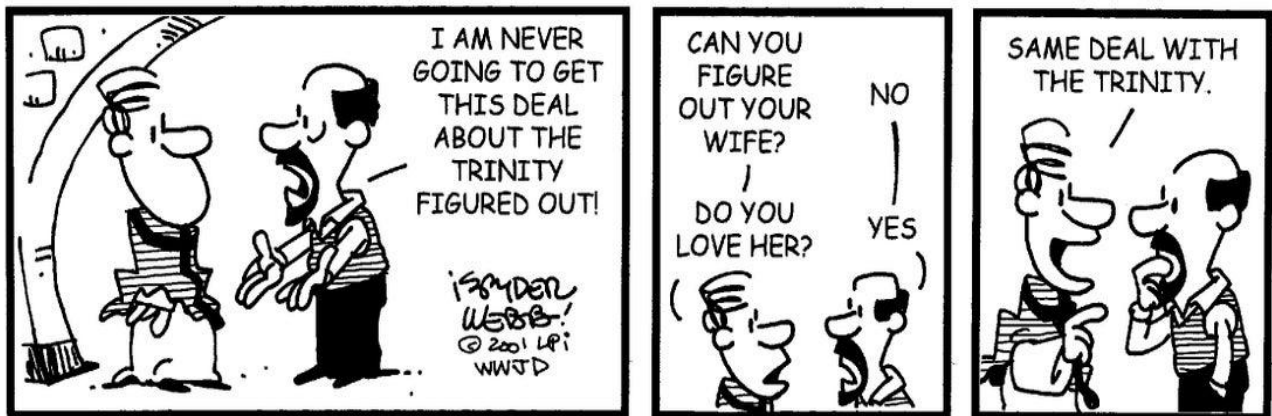
FLAT WANTED URGENTLY
