We are thrilled to invite you to join us for a very special occasion at St Brendan's. Our inaugural Baptism Programme is underway, and a wonderful group of students is preparing to


receive the Sacrament of Baptism. The baptism will take place at Our Lady of Grace on Friday, November 29th, at 9:30am.


Remembrance and recommitment ceremony (Rā Maumaharatanga) at **Korokoro cemetery:** You are welcome to join a peaceful hikoi starting beside the grave of famous chief Wi Tako at the Catholic Cemetery on the corner of Pito-one Street and Korokoro Road on Sunday 1 December 2024. Assemble at cemetery from 1:30pm. It is also a reminder of the joint kaitiakitanga of this special place, cared for by Wi Tako's descendants, the Love whanau, parishioners from Te Wairua Tapu / Holy Spirit parish, and the Hutt City Council. Wi Tako was buried at Korokoro in 1887 from St Peter and Paul's church in Lower Hutt.

Following the service we will proceed – by foot or vehicle – for 15 minutes to Te Puni urupā in Te Puni Street, then another 15 minutes to Sacred Heart Church, 41 Britannia Street to share stories and a cuppa. NB: please do not bring food on to the cemeteries, food will be provided at the church.


